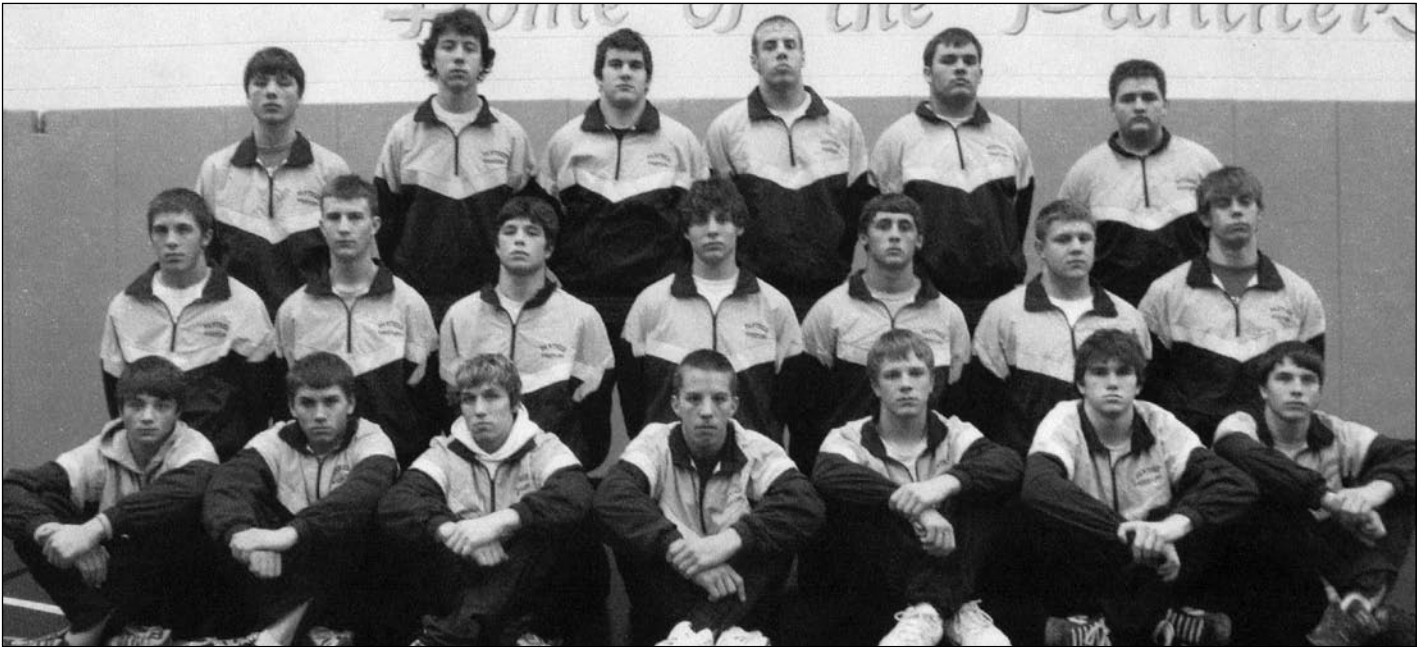


Meet the **Panthers** from SCOTT WEST, Minnesota

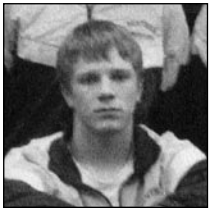

Tony Valek, a senior this year and team captian, was state champion last year at 125 lbs. So far his year he is undefeated with a record of 10-0.



Tim Hentges, a senior this year and team captian, was state runner up last year at 152 lbs. So far his year he is undefeated with a record of 10-0.

Scott West will be making its second appearance at The Clash. The Panthers placed 11th out of the 32 team tournament field at The Clash II. In its sixteen year wrestling history, Scott West has qualified for the the Minnesota State Team Tournament eight times, including the last four straight, placing 5th in 2003, 3rd in 2004, 2nd in 2005 and 6th in 2006.

The 2006-07 wrestling season marks the 17th year of Scott West Wrestling and the Panthers have produced 83 individual State Qualifiers, which include 40 State place winners and 10 State Champions. Several Scott West wrestlers have went on to compete at the collegiate level and the most noted of these would be three time State Champion Pat McNamara (1995-96-97), who went on to be a three-time All-American for Michigan State University. McNamara is currently an assistant coach at the Univiersity of Missouri.

1997 State Champion Tony Gansen would go on to become a two-time Divison I National Qualifier for Oklahoma State and Central Michigan. Gansen is currenly training at Colorado Springs.

Scott West has had two alumnist that have made a major impact at the Division III level for the Augsburg Auggies. Two-time State Champion Nick Slack (1996 and 98) would go on to be a three time National Finalist and one time champ. Most recently two-time State Placewinner (2001-02) Ryan Valek would become a three-time All-American and two-time National Runner-up.
